Notes from Galway Town Board Meeting, Sept. 20.

-The **Galway Highway Dept.** has been busy repaving roads and repairing those washed out by recent storms. Crews finished prep work on the **community events pavilion** that will also serve as a farmers market. It is hoped work on the pavilion will be completed next year, subject to budget constraints, etc.

-Galway received notice from the NYS Dept. of Taxation and Finance that the town's **equalization rate has risen from \$56.00 to \$53.00 which equates to a “tiny” reduction in taxes.**

-After complaints of a recent dog attack in Galway, council members cited the **town's leash law.** Copies are available at the Town Clerk's Office.

-The **Knolls Atomic Power Laboratory-Kesselring Site** in W. Milton is proposing to construct within the town of Galway a new radiological work and storage building.

-Next Town Board meeting will be held at the Town Hall Tues., Oct. 11, 7:30pm.
