Pan Pipe Straws July 1 at 1:00pm Make a musical instrument. Learn a little music history and create your own Pan Pipes.

Moving Pictures July 2 at 3:00pm Trick your eye and create a moving picture.

Super Simple Spectrometer July 2 at 6:00pm Use a cereal box, old CD and other materials to make a spectrometer.

Measure a Rainbow July 3 at 3:00pm Take the temperature of light. Use thermometers & basic supplies to experiment and compare results just like a scientist.

Make a Thaumatrope July 7 at 1:00pm Create and use a simple toy and explore how our eyes and brains work together to help us see.
