Meeting Called to Order by President Arlene Rhodes, 9:02 a.m.

- Note: Meeting called especially to review the results of the Nov. 2 Community Meeting surveys as done by Bill Bateman and Evelyn Hanna. However, one item of business must be taken care of first:
- **New Business**: Regarding the back door of the library which was discussed in the last minutes: Paul Foust has recommended we purchase a door that will be more resistant to damage from water and snow. He will donate his labor for the installation of the door. He recommends we purchase the door from Curtis Lumber Co., listed at \$367.00. They will provide a \$100 discount coupon. Dick Sleeper has offered to pay the remainder. Motion was made by Fred Baily to approve the purchase of the door under the conditions stated, Donna 2nd. 5 in favor 0 opposed, CARRIED Director will make the arrangements.

Review of Community Meeting

- Concerning the results of Community Members discussion: Everyone seemed to agree that we (and our earlier committee who reviewed the available sites) made the right decision – although several thought we might reconsider the decision based on the availability of the fire-house property.
