Frank Ferraro, Galway School District Business Administrator, discussed the **2017-18 school budget** at the Galway Seniors meeting on April 7. The proposed budget totals \$20,159,607. The prior year's budget was \$19,551.380; year to year increase is \$608, 227.; prior year's increase was \$847,260. Percent increase over last year: 3.11%; prior year's increase: 4.53%. **A budget hearing will be held May 4 and the school budget vote on May 16 at the high school.** Mr. Ferraro invited residents to call his office (882-1033 X4226) if they have questions about the proposed budget.
