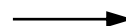
Voter registration day will be held on May 31 from 7:30AM to 3:30PM at Galway school.

Material can be brought to the Town Highway Garage between the hours of 6 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on the dates listed. Staff will be there to direct you to the proper location for the drop off. Please note the following items will NOT be accepted - No electronics of any kind, No Hazardous Materials such as paint thinners, petroleum products, old fertilizer, gas and oil, etc, No Household garbage and No propane tanks. Metal will be accepted, as well as refrigerators and freezers but they MUST be drained of refrigerants. (518)265-0426 (Highway Superintendent).
