



PUBLIC NOTICE OF VACANCY GALWAY PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Members of the public (18 years or older) who reside in the Galway Central School District who are interested in serving on the Library Board of Trustees may contact Deb Flint, Library Manager, at gal-director@sals.edu or call the library at 882-6385.

The appointment will be effective until the library elections in June 2017.

The board meets regularly on first and third Thursdays of each month, at 6:30pm at the library.

Candidates:

- Must be able to read and write
- Must be a qualified voter of the district, that is, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age or older, and not adjudged to be an incompetent (Note: a convicted felon is barred from running for a seat on a school board if his or her maximum prison sentence has not expired or if he or she has not been pardoned or discharged from parole)
 - Must be and have been a resident of the district for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one year immediately before the election, but need not be a taxpayer
 - May not have been removed from any library office within the preceding year
 - May not reside with another member of the same library board as a member of the same family
 - May not be a current employee of the library board
 - May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office
