
Community Announcements

Food for Thought

The holiday season is a great time to consider home made items for gifts. Those beautiful nuts that appear in the stores in bulk right about now were the perfect inspiration for brittle to delight the taste buds. Here is a simple and delicious recipe

Best-Ever Nut Brittle (from <u>foodandwine.com</u>)

TOTAL TIME: 20 mins plus cooling

SERVINGS: 2 pounds

2 cups sugar
1/2 cup water
1 stick unsalted butter
1/3 cup light corn syrup
1/2 teaspoon baking soda
12 ounces roasted salted peanuts,
cashews, pistachios and/or pecans
Fleur de sel or crushed Maldon sea
salt

In a large saucepan, combine the sugar, water, butter and corn syrup and bring to a boil. Cook over moderately high heat, stirring occasionally, until the caramel is light brown and registers 300° on a candy thermometer, 10 minutes. Remove from the heat and carefully stir in the baking soda. The mixture will bubble. Stir in the nuts, then immediately scrape the brittle onto a large rimmed, nonstick baking sheet. Using the back of a large spoon (oil it lightly if it sticks), spread the brittle into a thin, even layer. Sprinkle with salt. Let cool completely, about 30 minutes. Break the brittle into large shards.

Can be stored in an airtight container at room temperature for up to 1 month.
