An affiliate organization named the Saratoga Back Country Horsemen is being formed. The next meeting will be held Wednesday, Feb. 25th at 6:30pm at the CCE Room at 50 High Street in Ballston Spa. All who are interested in trail riding and support the efforts to ensure that public lands remain open to recreational equine trails are invited to attend and learn more about this group.
