Chocolate Cake Recipe – Courtesy of Gail Evans. (The Galway Get Together editor, Julie Ford Pasioka, would like to note that this is her go-to cake recipe and that she gets compliments on it every time! Enjoy!)

2 cups Sugar
1 cup Cocoa
½ tsp Salt
1 cup Oil
2 Eggs
1 tsp Vanilla
2 tsp Baking Soda
2 cups Warm Water
2 ¼ cups Flour

Mix ingredients and bake in an oiled and floured 9 x 13 pan at 350 degrees for approximately 60 minutes.
