Bulk Waste Drop Off

The Town of Galway will be conducting a bulk waste drop-off program for town residents June 8th thru June 12th at the Town Highway Garage at 5910 Sacandaga Road (NYS Route 147).

Times for the drop-off:

Wednesday June 8,
Thursday June 9, and
Friday June 10 - 6:00 a.m. until 6:30 p.m.
Saturday June 11 and
Sunday June 12 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

The following items will not be accepted:

No Electronics;
No Hazardous Materials e.g. paints, paint thinners and solvents, petroleum products (gas/oil), pesticides;
No Household Garbage;
No Propane Tanks;
No Tires.

Metal will be accepted as well as refrigerators and freezers BUT THEY MUST BE DRAINED OF REFRIGERANTS.

There will be highway employees assigned to this duty. Please see them before dropping off your waste so that they can direct you to the proper location.

It is recommended that participants know the basics of their camera already, i.e. focusing, using manual settings, how to change ISO, shutter speed, and F stops. The group size is limited to 12, and as this has proved to be a very popular workshop in the past, early registration is recommended.
