New Library Opening Set for September!

What a busy and exciting year it has been, starting with the awarding of new library bids last June! Site work began in July, and month by month we have watched our new library come to life both inside and out. The building will be substantially complete by the middle of June, and site work will continue into July. Furniture and shelving will be installed in August, followed by the relocation of books and equipment from the old library. Please mark your calendars for the Grand Opening of our new library, Saturday, September 21.

Hoosick Valley Construction, our general contractor, and Butler, Rowland and Mays Architects have guided us through the building process, providing excellent service each step of the way. A special thank you to our new library neighbors for their patience and understanding as the peace and quiet on East Street was disturbed by trucks and construction equipment delivering fill, moving earth, and blasting bedrock.

The library is being built with a combination of public and private funds. Public funds include bond monies approved by school district residents, \$1.15 million, and NYS Construction Aid and legislative grants, \$579,273 (\$311,804 of it expected in August). Additionally individuals, businesses and private foundations have donated \$1.36 million. We are grateful for every contribution. The library continues to seek additional funds to complete the audio-visual systems, furnishings and landscaping. All building fund donations of \$100 or more that are received by August 1, 2019 will be recognized on the donor wall in the lobby.

Our new library is an example of what we can accomplish as a community when we work together. Thank you all for your encouragement and your support. Please join us to celebrate our new library on Saturday, September 21!

Meet Santina Florio, elected to the Library Board of Trustees last June:

I moved to Galway in 2016, and soon learned that a new library building was under consideration. I saw it as the perfect opportunity to get involved in my new community. While I became a library trustee in July 2018, my involvement with libraries started long ago. Since childhood, libraries have always felt like a second home. I have vivid memories of going to my neighborhood library while growing up in Rhode Island. I spent many days there exploring the shelves, attending summer programs, and becoming a better reader. After college I moved around the country and explored several occupations, but ultimately my path led me back to a familiar place, and I became a school librarian.

Since joining the board last year, I have expanded my knowledge of libraries in a whole new way. In the next year, I am looking forward to the opening of the new building, to learning more about the Galway community, and to helping the library continue to be a valuable resource for all residents.

<u>Library Budget & Trustee Election Vote</u> — Wednesday, June 12 from 2 PM to 8 PM at the Galway Public Library, 5264 Sacandaga Rd.

A public information meeting on the budget will be held at the library on Wednesday, June 5, at 6 PM.

The public will be voting on a proposition to collect \$184,680 in school district property taxes for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 to operate the Galway Public Library.

There are 4 vacancies for Trustee on the Board. Two seats are for five-year terms of office that will begin on July 1, 2019 and end on June 30, 2024. These seats will be vacated by Fred Baily and Mary Lynn Kopper, who were elected on June 10, 2014. The two other seats are for one-year terms of office to fulfill previously elected terms. One seat is vacated by Jim Hodsoll who was appointed on July 18, 2018, to the seat vacated by Donna Erickson on June 21, 2018, whose term began on June 16, 2016, and whose term will end June 30, 2020. The second one-year seat will be vacated by Cate La Barre who was appointed on September 19, 2018, to the seat vacated by Kayla Dodds on August 17, 2018, whose term of office began on June 14, 2017, and whose term will end June 30, 2020. The 2 one-year seats will commence immediately after the election and end on June 30, 2020. Fred Baily, Jim Hodsoll, and Cate La Barre are running for re-election. The four seats are "at large," which means that each nominee is eligible to fill any available seat. The candidates with the most votes get the longer terms of office followed by the shorter terms of office. Any Galway School District resident who is a registered voter is eligible to vote in this election.
