

# \* Summer Reading Program\* Fantasy



## **Description:**

Frosted Glass Fantasy Light

#### **Materials:**

- Glass jar with opening large enough to put your hand in
- Elmer's-type glue
- Paint brush or foam brush
- White or clear glitter
- Black silhouette of fairy or dragon available at the library
- Battery-operated tealight candle or fairy lights
- Optional: decorations such as twine, charms, ribbons, silk flowers, beads

### Note/Tip:

 You can also draw and cut out your own silhouette from black paper

#### **Instructions:**

- Apply the silhouette to the inside of the jar
  - if your silhouette is self-stick, just place it where you want it and stick to the glass
  - if your silhouette is paper, spread glue on it and glue inside the jar
- Paint the whole inside of the jar (and back of the silhouette) with a good layer of glue
- Pour some glitter into the jar and roll the jar to spread the glitter throughout the inside
- If desired, put some glue on the outside of the jar (not on the threads where the cap goes) and sprinkle with more glitter
- When the glue is dry, place the battery-operated light inside
- Turn out the light in the room or go into a dark area like a closet to really admire your fairy light
