Notifications

To manage which push notifications on Android and iOS devices:

1. Go to the menu icon ≡
2. Go to *Settings > Manage Notifications*.
3. If prompted, allow Libby to send push notifications.
4. Choose how to be notified: **Ignore** (no notification), **Menu badge** (in-app menu notification), or **Notification** (push notification).

[If you use Libby in your web browser](#) - you can get in-app or email notifications for your loans and holds. Push notifications aren't supported. By default, you'll get in-app notifications, which appear in the menu.

If you'd like to receive email notices instead, here's how to set them up:

1. Go to the menu icon ≡
2. Go to *Settings > Manage Notifications*.
3. Select **Email notice** for any event you'd like an email about.
4. Select **Fix this?** next to "You need to specify an email address..." (at the bottom of the menu), then enter your email and select **Next**.

Notes

- Once you set up Libby on your mobile device you should automatically get signed in
- Each time there is an update to the app, you will receive a page with the highlights of what changed

Tags

Tags are a flexible way to organize books in Libby.

You can use tags to make a list of what you want to read, your favorites, what you've borrowed, and more.

You can find your tags on your **Shelf** under **tags**.

Once you select a tag from your **Shelf**, you can borrow a tagged title, filter the tag by format, export a list of titles in the tag, and rename or delete the tag.

You can tag titles from all of your libraries and create as many tags as you'd like.

Reading history

You can use your **Timeline** 🕒 to track your reading history in Libby. On your timeline, you'll see a list of titles you've borrowed, placed on hold, renewed, and returned from all your libraries. Your timeline is specific to the device you're on.

If you only want to see titles you've borrowed, visit your "borrowed" tag (under *tags*). Libby automatically creates this tag for you, and it will sync across devices as long as you use a setup code when setting up Libby on your other devices.

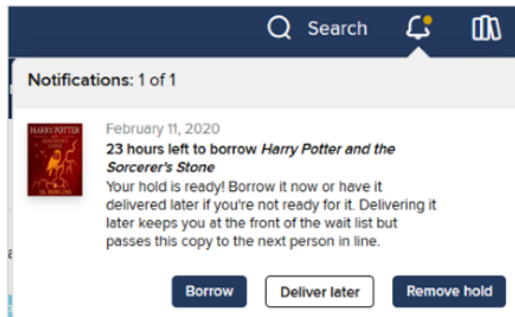

- When a hold becomes available for you, you'll now have the option to borrow it or [have it delivered later](#). The "deliver later" option keeps you at the front of the wait list but passes that copy of the title to the next person in line. This feature gives you more control over your holds, so you can borrow and read titles when it's most convenient for you.



- The auto-checkout option for holds has been removed. Instead, all users can go to their **Holds** page to borrow available holds.
- Your library's digital collection now has a notification section to alert you about available holds.

Note: You'll still receive email notifications about your holds.
