Director's Report February 2023

Building & Grounds:

- Sent signed contract to Perfect Water. They are scheduled to come at the end of the month.
- During the bitter cold on February 4, the water was not flowing to some of the sinks in the building. A plumber came and recommended opening the ceiling tiles in the mechanical room and hallway, and increasing heat with heater in mechanical room and portable electric heaters. This fixed the problem. There appears to be no lasting effects. This has never been an issue before.
- I took down the ripped US flag from outside. A volunteer donated a replacement. I will hang it after the snow melts.
- Have had to close early and open late several times in the past month for weather conditions.
- Have a community service person cleaning windows, etc. around the building.

Collection:

- Added 140 new books, 58 donations, and 1 DVD in January.
- Ordered new books and DVDs.
- Decided not to renew the Junior Library Guild book subscription because of the cost increase.
- Weeded Junior Fiction because of a lack of space.
- There are now emagazines available to all patrons in Overdrive thanks to the three large libraries in our system.
- Swapped out a number of classic literature copies for better, newer copies using donated books.

Community Outreach:

- Galway high school art students will be the artist of the month for March. They will have an
 opening reception at the library on March 3 from 4-6pm to show off their art to the community
 and answer questions. The plan is for this to be an annual event.
- Wrote thank you notes to the town supervisors in appreciation for econtent funding in the County budget for SALS libraries.

Continuing Education:

- Attended a webinar on Crisis Management.
- Began a series of webinars on Interlibrary Loans.

Financials:

- I contacted more CPAs to request an audit done with government standards. I am waiting on an actual quote.
- Worked on budget more; met with Finance Committee to discuss FY 23-24 budget.
