Wednesday, June 3rd | 2-8 PM

AT THE LIBRARY

All registered voters in the Galway Central School District may vote in the Library's annual budget election. There are no trustees up for re-election this year.







The public will vote on a proposition to collect \$258,900 in property taxes to operate the library for the **2026-2027 fiscal year**.

A budget information meeting will be held at the library on **Wednesday, May 27th at 6:30pm**.
